<b>1</b>	Has eyes	Go to 2
	No eyes	Go to 3

<b>2</b>	Has legs	Go to 4
	No legs	Go to 5

<b>3</b>	Has tentacles	Jellyfish
	No tentacles	Go to 6

<b>4</b>	Body is worm-like	Bristle Worm (Polychaete)
	Body not worm-like	Go to 7

<b>5</b>	Has tentacles	Squid Larva
	No tentacles	Go to 8

<b>6</b>	Has wings	Sea Butterfly (Thecosomata)
	No wings	Go to 9

<b>7</b>	Single spine on back of head	Crab Larva (Zoea Stage)
	No single spine on back of head	Go to 10

<b>8</b>	Body is inside an egg	Fish Egg
	Body is not inside an egg	Fish Larva

<b>9</b>	Body is see-through	Go to 11
	Body is not see-through	Coral Larva

<b>10</b>	Single, central eye	Copepod
	No single, central eye	Krill (Euphausiid)

<b>11</b>	Has cilia	Comb Jelly (Ctenophore)
	No cilia	Salp
